

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE TO CONVERT THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CLINTON,
ARKANSAS INTO A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated
town of Clinton, Arkansas;

WHEREAS: The Town of Clinton, Arkansas, is an incorporated
town and is also the County Seat of Van Buren County, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS: By Act 334 of Acts of Arkansas for the year of 1937
it is provided that County Sites, that are incorporated town may
be converted into cities of the second class.

THEREFORE: Be it ordained by the Town Council of the town of
Clinton, Arkansas, that said incorporated town be converted into
a city of the Second Class.

Be it therefore ordained that an election be called by the
mayor of the town of Clinton, Arkansas, for the purpose of
allowing the qualified electors to vote on said conversion of
said town into a city of the Second Class.
