

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE KEEPING OF PREMISES IN SANITARY CONDITION, PROVIDING FOR THE CLEANING OF TOILETS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. Every property owner or tenant within the city limits of the City of Clinton must keep his premises clean --- keeping said premises free of all tin cans, scraps of iron and other rubbish.

SECTION 2. Premises as designated in Section 1 hereof shall include all alleys adjoining such lots occupied.

SECTION 3. All toilets within the city limits must be kept in sanitary condition. Every toilet must be cleaned properly at least once each month.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in any sum not less than \$1.00 nor in any sum greater than \$10.00.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage.
