

**ORDINANCE NO. 2001-03**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISPOSAL OF INORGANIC  
DEBRIS  
ON CITY PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton has determined that the disposal of debris on city property constitutes a health and safety hazard and increases the cost of maintaining city owned property:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:


That the City hereby prohibits the disposal, storage, or abandonment of all inorganic debris of any kind on city property. Nothing in this ordinance shall prohibit the disposal of organic materials on city property.


“Organic materials” are plant or tree waste which has not been manufactured or refined.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
