

ORDINANCE NO. 5,865 CS

**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 22;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Clinton, Arkansas, passed and adopted Ordinance No. 22 on July 14, 1941, which prohibited dancing in public places within the corporate city limits of the City of Clinton, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 22 is no longer necessary and needs to be repealed.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1.** Ordinance No. 22 which was passed on July 14, 1941, is hereby repealed.


**Section 5.** Emergency Clause:


