

**AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING CERTAIN MATTERS
WITH RESPECT TO THE PROPOSED CLINTON SENIOR CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton intends to apply to the Arkansas Development of Economic Development (ADED) for a Community and Economic Development Program grant for expansion of the current senior citizens facility; and

WHEREAS, one of the conditions on receiving ADED funding is the dedication of the facility for programs and services benefiting senior citizens.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council of Clinton hereby declares that the senior citizens facility, to be funded in part with ADED funds, be dedicated exclusively for programs and services benefiting senior citizens.

2. It has been found that the effectiveness of this Ordinance is necessary for the receipt of financial assistance which is essential to the expansion of the senior citizens center. Therefore, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in force upon its passage and approval.


