ORDINANCE NO. D.OO3-11

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2002-08 REGARDING THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF TRANSIENT MERCHANTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2002, the City of Clinton, Arkansas, adopted Ordinance No. 2002-08, which provides for the licensing and regulation of transient merchants; and

WHEREAS, since the implementation of said Ordinance the City Council has determined that some changes to said Ordinance are appropriate in order to regulate transient merchants within the city while continuing to provide opportunities for economic activities for merchants.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance 2002-08 is amended to read as follows:

- a) Any transient merchant desiring to transact business in the City of Clinton shall make application for and obtain a license.
- b) The application for license shall include the following information:
 - The name and permanent address of the transient merchant making application and, if the applicant is a firm or corporation, the name and address of the members of the firm or the officers of the corporation, as the case may be;
 - 2) If the applicant is a corporation, there shall be stated on the application form the date of incorporation, the state of incorporation and, if the applicant is a corporation formed in a state other than the State of Arkansas, the date on which the corporation qualified to transact business as a foreign corporation in the State of Arkansas;
 - 3) A statement showing the kind of business proposed to be conducted, the length of time for which the applicant desires to transact such business, and the location of the proposed place of business;

- 4) The name and permanent address of the transient merchant's registered agent or office;
- c) The City Clerk shall design and cause to be printed appropriate forms for applications for licenses and for the license certificates to be issued to applicants under this subchapter.

Section 2. Section 7 of Ordinance 2002-08 is amended to read as follows:

- a) The application for a transient merchant license shall be accompanied by a fee of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- b) The fee required in subsection (a) above may be waived by a vote of the Clinton City Council upon a request by an applicant for such a license.

Section 3.

 All provisions of Ordinance 2002-08 not modified by this Ordinance shall remain in effect.
