

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-65

**ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 152 TO ADD THE
DESIGNEE OF THE MAYOR AS A POTENTIAL FLOODPLAIN
ADMINISTRATOR AND ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR
APPLICATIONS PURSUANT TO THE ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton passed Ordinance 152 on October 1, 1986, to deal with flood damage control; and,

WHEREAS, the requirements of being the Floodplain Administrator has become exceedingly more technical and difficult over the past several years; and,

WHEREAS, it is essential to the City of Clinton that it have a Floodplain Administrator that is well versed in the numerous technical requirements of floodplain development; and,

WHEREAS, the effective administration of the Floodplain is of such a nature that it may be difficult for a full time mayor to spend the time necessary on such application;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Article 4, Section A, of Ordinance 152 is hereby amended to add the Designee of the Mayor as an alternative to the Mayor being the Floodplain Administrator.

Section 2. A new Article 6 is hereby added which reads as follows:


Section A. There is hereby levied a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for a Floodplain Determination to be made by the Floodplain Administrator. Said fee shall be paid to the City Clerk prior to any such determination made by the Administrator.

Section B. There is hereby levied a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for a Floodplain Development Permit. Said fee shall be reduced by any fee paid pursuant to Section A. above provided the

fee paid under Section A. is for the same property a permit is requested for under Section B.


Section C. All fees collected pursuant to Sections A and B above shall be used to pay the Floodplain Administrator for his or her work in administering this Ordinance provided, however, that said fees shall go into the City general fund if the Mayor is the Administrator.
