

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2011-04

AN ORDINANCE LEVING 2.9 MILL REAL PROPERTY TAX
FOR GENERAL OPERATIONS OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS;
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton, Arkansas, is required to pass an Ordinance setting forth the millage rate for property taxes to be collected for the City of Clinton, Arkansas, in the next year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton, Arkansas, desires that the property taxes for the year of 2012 increased as to provide a means to fund additional improvements, repairs or expenditures; and

WHEREAS, such an Ordinance must be passed and provided to the Van Buren County Assessor's and Collectors Offices, by the time of the Van Buren County Quorum Court's November meeting.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Clinton, Arkansas, hereby levies and assesses a 2.9 mill real property tax on real property in Van Buren County as prescribed by law, for the year 2012, which tax shall be collected by Van Buren County, Arkansas.


Section 2. It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance must be provided to the Van Buren County Assessor's and Collectors offices immediately to allow those offices time to implement it. This ordinance is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, and therefore shall be enforced from and after the date of its passage. The Clerk is directed to immediately provide a certified copy of this Ordinance to the offices of the Van Buren County Assessor and the Van Buren County Collector.
