

ORDINANCE NO. ~~104~~ ¹⁰⁷

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THE LOCATION AND NUMBER OF ALDERMANIC WARDS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Clinton, Arkansas, as presently platted shall be divided into three (3) wards and are described as follows:

a. Ward No. 1 shall be bounded on the South by a line running East and West to the corporate limits along and with Main Street and bounded by the corporate limits on the North, East, and West.

b. Ward No. 2 shall be bounded on the North by the southern boundary of Ward No. 1; bounded on the East by a line beginning at the junction of Main and Moss Streets and running South along and with Moss Street to US Highway 65 and thence continuing southerly along the eastern border of Section Fifteen (15), Township Eleven (11) North, Range Thirteen (13) West, to the junction of Patton and Hall Streets; thence along Hall Street to the junction of Hall and Hemp Streets; thence South along the eastern border of Section Fifteen (15) to the corner of Sections Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Twenty-two (22), and Twenty-three (23); thence South along the eastern border of Section Twenty-two (22) to the corporate limits, and bordered on the South and West by the corporate limits.

c. Ward No. 3 shall be all the remainder of the City of Clinton which lies East of Ward No. 2 and South of Ward No. 1.

Section 2. Each Ward shall be represented by two (2) aldermen who shall be designated Alderman Number One and Alderman Number Two. Each candidate shall meet such residency requirements and other requirements as is now provided by law.

Section 3. Each of the present aldermen shall immediately upon passage of this ordinance, designate which position and which ward they shall consider themselves as occupying for the remainder of their respective terms. Any vacancies created by this ordinance shall be filled according to law as soon as practicable.

Section 4. A map shall be prepared which depicts the wards as herein defined and shall be kept on file at the City Hall.

Section 5. It is hereby found that the present structure of the City Council of the City of Clinton is not in compliance with Arkansas Law pertaining to Cities of the Second Class and in order to adequately and fairly represent the Citizens of this City, an emergency is therefore declared and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
