

ORDINANCE NO. 120

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BOND FOR CUTTING  
STREETS OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:**

WHEREAS, various parties have cut the streets of Clinton, Arkansas, for the emplacement or repair of utilities, or other construction projects, and have left said streets in disrepair resulting in the expenditure of public funds for repair of said streets;

BE IT ORDAINED, That any party either public or private, except the Clinton Water Department, and any other agency of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, shall post a Bond in the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY AND 00/00 DOLLARS (\$150.00) with the City Clerk for the purpose of compensating the City should the party fail to repair said city street.

It is declared that an Emergency exists, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and well being shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
