Ordinance Number 140

WHEREAS, Ark. Stat. Ann. §19-909 requires that before any supplies may be purchased or services provided by a firm in which a city alderman has an interest, and

WHEREAS, Alderman Jackson has an ownership interest in the Van Buren County Democrat, which is the only newspaper publishing in Van Buren County, and


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to publish in this paper, and

WHEREAS, the City occasionally purchases small amounts of supplies from Bones Thriftway Super Foods store in which Alderman Bone has an ownership interest, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City that the City be permitted to make purchases of services and supplies from these businesses, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to lease vehicles from Loy Dewey, City Police Chief.

NOW, therefore, be it ordained that the City may use the services of the Van Buren County Democrat and purchase supplies from Bones Thriftway Super Foods, Clinton, Arkansas and enter into a vehicular lease agreement with Loy Dewey, City Police Chief.
