


ORDINANCE NO. 163

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NOS. 33, 36, 42 AND 49 AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO THE CREATION, COLLECTION AND ENFORCEMENT OF AN OCCUPATION TAX FOR BUSINESSES WITHIN THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Clinton has resolved that the tax and license generally known as the Occupation Tax does not properly and equitably apply to all of the various businesses within the City of Clinton, and moreover that collection and enforcement of said tax cannot be maintained without undue hardship and expense;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that ordinances now in effect and appearing in the City of Clinton record books as Ordinance Number 33, Ordinance Number 36, Ordinance Number 42 and Ordinance Number 49 are hereby and hereafter deemed repealed and of no force and effect.
