

**AN ORDINANCE TO PRESCRIBE AN AREA WITHIN THE CITY OF CLINTON TO BE USED AS A FARMER'S AND PEDDLER'S MARKET.**

WHEREAS, there is a critical deficiency of parking places around the town square of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, and

WHEREAS, farmers and peddlers of food produce have a practice and tradition of utilizing their vehicles to display and sell food produce around the town square of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, and

WHEREAS, the City of Clinton, Arkansas Ordinance No. 65 prohibits said farmers and peddlers from parking their vehicles for the purpose of selling food produce on city streets around and extending away from the town square as described in said ordinance;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. The following described area including the southern portion of the Clinton State Bank Parking Lot within the City of Clinton, Arkansas shall be designated as a Farmer's Marketplace: The southern boundary of said farmer's market zone shall be five (5') feet to the north and parrallel to the Lefler Building which adjoins the Clinton State Bank Parking Lot. The northern boundary shall be forty (40') feet to the north of and parallel to said Lefler Building. The east boundary shall extend to Court Street and the west boundary shall extend to Boykin Street.

Section 2. Any farmers and peddlers shall park and stay within the zone described in Section (1) for the purpose of selling their food produce within the City of Clinton. Said restrictions as to place of sale of food produce applies whether or not a farmer or peddler utilizes a motor vehicle to carry and display food stuffs for sale. Said restriction does not apply to merchants situated in buildings.

Section 3. Anyone who does not stay within the farmer's market zone as described hereinabove shall be subject to a fine in any sum not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00 upon conviction.
