

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE POLICE PENSION FUND COURT COST.

BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

WHEREAS the City desires to provide for retirement benefits for Municipal Police under a state operated retirement system and

WHEREAS, the City now has a \$1.00 court cost being assessed pursuant to Ordinance Number 154 adopted on January 8, 1987 and


WHEREAS, the anticipated retirement plan under LOPFI excludes local retirement plans there is a need to abolish the Municipal Police Pension Fund Court Costs.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that so much of Ordinance Number 154 which establishes said court cost for the Municipal Police Pension Fund is repealed and all funds now being held by the City Treasurer from this Fund shall be transferred to the General Revenue Fund of the City for such purposes as the City Council deems necessary and proper.
