

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-14

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-11 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPOINT TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS TO PARTICIPATE WITH THE MAYOR TO DETERMINE RESERVES TO BE PLACED ON ITEMS OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO BE OFFERED FOR SALE ON AUCTIONS .**

WHEREAS, the city of Clinton, Arkansas (the "City"), by Ordinance 2008-11, authorized the Mayor to offer for sale items of surplus municipal property at public or-line auction sales; and

WHEREAS, the sale of such items usually have reserve set by the owner thereof; and


WHEREAS, City Council member should participate in setting those reserves:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

That the Mayor is hereby given authority and is authorized to appoint not less than two members of the Clinton City Council to participate with him in setting a reserve on items to be offered for sale by on-line auction. This ordinance does not preclude setting a reserve at zero (0).
