

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-01

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CLINTON CITY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2007-12, SECTION 4, PARAGRAPH 13  
ESTABLISHING MATERIALS SPECIFICATIONS AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 2007-12 did not adequately provide a specification for construction of RV sites; and

**WHEREAS**, the growth of the City of Clinton and the demand for recreational vehicle parks and the standards of construction thereof require durable and attractive sites; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Clinton has considered that the development of RV parks and individual parking sites should meet certain minimum standards to assure durability, safety, and attractiveness;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS THAT CLINTON CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2007-12, SECTION 4, PARAGRAPH 13 BE AND THE SAME HEREBY IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 4:** General Requirements:


13. All sites must be on a reasonably level grade of no more than two inch (2") of fall for each twelve feet (12') of length, **constructed of asphalt or four inches (4) of concrete, and** must meet the state requirements of distance apart.

14. It is necessary for the efficient operations of the Municipal Government of the City of Clinton that an enforceable zoning ordinance be available to ensure standards of construction meet and/or exceed minimum requirements. And, further, because an RV park construction is currently in progress and to ensure that the standards required by the ordinance are clearly understood immediately, that an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public interests, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage and approval.
