

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PURCHASING  
POWERS AND LIMITATIONS IN TRANSACTIONS  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS  
AND MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND  
EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set limits on the amount of those purchases of products and services by the City of Clinton from those persons who serve on the City Council of the City of Clinton and who are employees of the City of Clinton;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS;

SECTION 1. The City is herewith authorized to purchase products or services from Van Buren County Democrat in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$ 5,000.00) per year for publication supplies.

SECTION 2. The City is herewith authorized to purchase products or services from Loy Dewey, presently employed in the City Police Department, in an amount not to exceed Seven Thousand Five Hundred & no/100 Dollars (\$ 7,500.00) for the payment of services and/or materials rendered by Loy Dewey or any business which he owns.

SECTION 3. The City is herewith authorized to purchase products or services from Davis Motor Company in an amount not to exceed Twenty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$ 20,000.00) for the purpose of the acquisition of parts, or maintenance of motor vehicles owned or leased by the City.

SECTION 4. The City is herewith authorized to purchase products or services from James Beavers, in an amount not to exceed Five Thousdan and no/100 Dollars (\$ 5,000.00) for the purpose of the acquisition of auto parts for maintenance of motor vehicles owned or leased by the City.

SECTION 5. All provisions of any prior Ordinance which are contrary to or in conflict with any of the provisions hereinabove set out, are hereby repealed and of no force and effect. This Ordinance supersedes Ordinance No. 95-225 and Amendments thereto.

SECTION 6. It is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary to preserve the peace, health, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Clinton and therefore shall be enforced from and after the date of this passage.
