

ORDINANCE NO. 99-270

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SEWER USE ORDINANCE NO. 98-260

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLINTON,
ARKANSAS:

Section 1. Clinton City Ordinance No. 98-260, Article IV, Section 2, is hereby amended and modified as follows:


Article IV., Section 2. There shall be two classes of building sewer permits; (a) for residential and commercial service, and (b) for service to establishments producing industrial wastes. In either case, the owner(s) or his agent shall make application on a special form furnished by the City. The permit application shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications, or other information considered pertinent in the judgment of the Superintendent. A permit and inspection fee of \$50.00 dollars for residential service shall be paid to the City at the time application for service is made upon the condition that the application for a permit is filed with the City in the appropriate form within sixty (60) days of notice by publication in a local newspaper or personal notification that the sewer is available to the resident. In all other circumstances, a permit and inspection fee of \$150.00 dollars for residential, and \$175.00 dollars for industrial or commercial permits shall be paid to the City at the time the application is filed.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. It has been determined that this Ordinance is necessary and is vital to the health, welfare and safety of the public, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
