

ORDINANCE NO. 23 (AMEND ORD. 7, SECTION 1)

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DRINKING AND DRUNKENNESS IN PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE INCORPORATED CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS MISDEMEANOR ----- PUNISHMENT.

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That any person who shall in any public place, or upon any public highway, or any street or in or upon any vehicle, or in or about any depot, platform, waiting station or room or bus depot or station within the incorporated city of Clinton, Arkansas drink any intoxicating liquor of any kind, or if any person shall be drunk or intoxicated in any public place, or building, or at any public gathering, or if any person shall be drunk and disorderly, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after its publication.
