

ORDINANCE NO. 38

REPEALING OF ORDINANCE NO. 20

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to place, deposit or dump, or caused to be placed, deposited or dumped, any garbage, swill, trash or rubbish, or any noisome, nauseous or offensive matter in or upon the streets or alleys of Clinton, or in or upon any public highway or road including any portion of the right of way thereof; or in or upon any private property into or upon which the public is admitted be easement, or license, or any private property without the consent of the owner or in or upon any public park, or other public property other than the property designated or set aside for such purposes by the City Council. No portion of this section shall be construed to restrict a private owner in the use of his own private property.

SECTION 2. A writ of attachment may be issued against any vehicle used in violating the provisions of this act for the collection of any fine assessed hereunder.

SECTION 3. Any person, persons, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance or any part hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction be fined, not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$200.00 and cost.

SECTION 4. An ordinance or parts of ordinances that conflict herewith are hereby repealed and held for nought.
