

ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING BURNING OF TRASH ON THE STREETS OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, in regular session assembled that:

SECTION 1. No one shall be permitted to burn any paper, leaves, trash, or rubbish of any kind in the streets, alleys, or highways, including any portion of the right-of-way thereof, nor upon any public property within the City of Clinton.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

Passed at Clinton, Arkansas, this the 13th day of September 1948, and published in the Van Buren County Democrat.
