

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DISTURBING PUBLIC PEACE IN THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated town of Clinton, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1. If any person shall wilfully or maliciously disturb the peace and quiet of any person by loud or unusual noise, guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not more than \$300.00 or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than one month nor more than six months, or both at the discretion of the court.

This ordinance was approved on the nineteenth day of April, 1938, and advertised on the twenty-first day of April, 1938.
