

ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS, TO WITHHOLD SOCIAL SECURITY TAX FROM WAGES OF CITY EMPLOYEES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Clinton, Arkansas, are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the State of Arkansas for the purpose of obtaining insurance coverages for all the non-uniform employees of the City under the terms and provisions of the Federal Social Security Act.

SECTION 2. That commencing January 1, 1954, each employee's insurance contribution shall be deducted from his salary check in accordance with the terms and provisions of the said Social Security Act.

SECTION 3. That commencing January 1, 1954, there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Clinton, Arkansas the sums of money necessary to pay the City's share of the insurance tax in accordance with the terms and provisions of the said Social Security Act.

SECTION 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
