

ORDINANCE NO. 7

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT DRUNKENNESS IN THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CLINTON, ARKANSAS.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated town of Clinton, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1. Any person who shall appear in a drunken or intoxicated condition upon the streets, alleys or by ways or public square or any other public place in the Incorporated town of Clinton, Arkansas, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of any peace officer to arrest said person and bring them forthwith before the mayor of the Incorporated town of Clinton, Arkansas, to be dealt with according to the provisions of this act.

That this ordinance be in force from and after its passage and publication and all ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
