

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL COURT, JUDGE'S QUALIFICATIONS, SALARY, TERM OF OFFICE, AND MANNER OF ELECTION AND FILING OF VACANCIES.

Be it enacted by the City Council of the City of Clinton, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. A municipal court under the provision of Ark. Stat. Anno. 22-732 through 22-738 is hereby created and established.

SECTION 2. The judge of the municipal court shall be at least twenty-five (25) years of age, of good moral character, an attorney at law in good standing and shall have been in the active practice of law for at least six (6) years, two (2) year resident of the state and an elector of the judicial subdivision wherein the court sits.

SECTION 3. The annual salary of the municipal judge shall be \$2,400.00 per year, payable in equal monthly installments, one-half to be paid by the city of Clinton and the other half to be paid by Van Buren County.

SECTION 4. The municipal judge shall be elected by a majority of the votes cast for said office by the qualified electors of Van Buren County for a term of four years and until his successor is elected and qualified. Any vacancies existing in said office shall be filled by appointment by the City Council of the City of Clinton and said appointee shall serve until the next general election and until his successor is elected and qualified.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.

SECTION 6. If any part or parts of this ordinance is invalid, the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected.
