ORDINANCE NO. 88-176

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PURCHASING
POWERS AND LIMITATIONS IN TRANSACTIONS
BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON AND
MEMBERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY
COUNSEL AND TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 157

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 157 should be amended to include all City Aldermen from whom the city may purchase products and services and to set a limit on the amount of those purchases, and

WHEREAS, Alderman Jackson has an ownership interest in the Van Buren County Democrat, which is the only newspaper publishing in Van Buren County, and WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to publish in this paper, and

WHEREAS, the City occasionally purchases small amounts of supplies from Bone's Thriftway Super Foods store in which Alderman Bone has an ownership interest, and WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City that the City be permitted to make purchases of services and supplies from these businesses, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to lease vehicles from Loy Dewey, City Police Chief,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. The City may purchase the products or services of the Van Buren County Democrat in an amount not to exceed \$5000.00 per year for publication & supplies.

Section 2. The City may purchase the products or services of Bone's Thriftway Super Foods Market in an amount not to exceed \$1200.00 per year for supplies.

Section 3. The City may purchase the products or services of Loy Dewey in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for lease, fuel and maintenance of three police cars.

Section 4. All provisions of any prior ordinances, which are contrary to or in conflict with any of the provisions of provisions hereinabove set out, are hereby repealed and of no effect.
