ORDINANCE NO. 89-184

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PURCHASING
POWERS AND LIMITATIONS IN TRANSACTIONS
BETWEEN THE CITY OF CLINTON AND MEMBERS
AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY AND TO AMEND
ORDINANCE NO. 157

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 157 should be amended to include newly elected City Alderman and Officers from whom the City may purchase products and services and to set a limit on the amount of those purchases, and

WHEREAS, Alderman L. J. Davis has an ownership interest in the Dodge Chrysler Dealership and attendant businesses located in Clinton, and WHEREAS, it may become necessary for the City to do business with L. J. Davis, and

WHEREAS, City Recorder Charles Hicks has an ownership interest in business pertaining to welding and general repair of equipment and goods, and WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City that the City be permitted to make purchases of services and supplies from this business, and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:


Section 1. The City may purchase the products or services from the Clinton Dodge Chrysler Dealership and attendant businesses in an amount not to exceed 5000.00.

Section 2. The City may purchase the products or services from Charles Hicks in an amount not to exceed 5000.00

Section 3. All specific provisions of any prior ordinances, which are contrary to or in conflict with any of the provisions hereinabove set out, are hereby repealed and of no effect.
