

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Incorporated town of Clinton, Arkansas, that:

That any person who shall wear or carry in any manner whatever as a weapon, any dirk or bowie knife, or sword or spear in a cane, brass or metal knucks, razor or any pistol of any kind whatever, within the limits of the town of Clinton, Arkansas, provided nothing in this ordinance shall be so concerned as to prohibit any person from carrying such pistols as are used in Army and Navy of the United States, when carried uncovered and in the hand, provided officers whose duties require them to make arrests, or to keep and guard prisoners, together with persons summoned by such officers to aid them in the discharge of such duties while actually engaged in such duties, are exempt from the provisions of the ordinance.

Penalty: Any person convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00; or both fine and imprisonment.

This ordinance to be in full force and effect on and after the publication of same.
